*HBHF Friday Dubs Weekly Tournament entry fees for Open/Am players includes \$1/ea for the Ace Pool. By simply subtracting the Club's seed money from the total Ace payouts you get a fairly accurate count of the amount of players for the past 4/yrs. When there is an 'Odd Person', and they pay for an extra throw, they pay into the Ace Pool as well as cash awards, maybe 10-20x yearly, so a slightly more accurate # of players would be between 2820-2860 total players for the past 4/yrs

**Multiplying all participants for 4/yrs x \$5 gives us this figure. However, throughout the 4/yr Dubs history we have played two divisions when there are enough players for both Open & Am divisions. Open players pitch in \$10 for the cash awards pool opposed to \$5. For every 100 Open players being split into their own higher payout cash division there is an additional \$500 thrown into Total Cash Payouts. Of the virtual 200 Friday Dubs Weeklies hosted by the club in the past 4/yrs there is a minimum of 200-400 Open players, and more, out of about 2850+ total players, which increases the Total Cash Prizes awarded another \$1-2k minimum, it's most likely even higher than that. \$2-4k or more

***Tack on another \$2-4k minimum when Friday Dubs have been run in split divisions and you're looking at somewhere between \$20-22k in Total Cash prizes being awarded to all of the Friday Dubs players collectively over a 4/yr timespan. The majority of all Fridays Dubs players are course locals, and/or Club members, our fellow So Cal disc golfers from neighboring courses & friends, family and visitors nationwide and worldwide
